
This is a book of commentaries on the state of the world, travel, and contemporary policy challenges, with a lot of criss-crossing of disciplinary boundaries, all written from the perch of an economist. Between the publication of the original edition of the book and the present one, the author made a transition leaving the groves of academe for seven years in the world of policymaking, in the Indian government and later at the World Bank. This new and expanded edition includes essays and op-eds written after this transition. Many of the new essays cover more urgent policy matters, written from a proximity of where they were conceived.

Kaushik Basu is professor of economics and C. Marks Professor of International Studies at Cornell University, USA. He was formerly chief economist and senior vice president of the World Bank, and prior to that chief economic adviser to the Indian government. Basu has published widely in several fields, including development economics, game theory, welfare economics, and law and economics. He has also published in the popular press, including the *New York Times*, BBC News online, and the *Indian Express*. He has received honorary doctorates from several universities and, including IIT Bombay, India. In 2008, he was awarded the Padma Bhushan by the president of India.

Liberalisation officially began in 1991, but the seed for it was sown in the late 1950s by proponents of free markets. The debates over the opening up of the domestic market continued through the 1960s in India, resulting in fitful bursts of reforms. It was only from the mid-1980s that talk of liberalisation gathered steam, culminating in the decision to relax economic norms in 1991. Though the decision to scrap industrial licences and ease the restrictions on FDI and imports signalled absolute belief in the virtues of competition,






This book provides an account of economic development in Palanpur, a village in rural North India, based on five detailed surveys of the village over the period 1957 to 1993. These five decades have seen economic well-being rise in some important

respects, but stagnation and even decline in other areas. The analysis presented here focusses on the reasons behind this uneven progress. The authors tie in the background issues of the evolution of poverty, inequality, and mobility over time with causal factors such as technological progress, demographic and sectoral changes, the operation of markets, and the role of public action.


How Lives Change sets out the role of, and scope for, public policy in shaping

the lives of individuals. It describes how changes in Palanpur's economy since the late 1950s were initially driven by the advance of agriculture through land reforms, the expansion of irrigation, and the introduction of 'Green Revolution' technologies. Since the mid-1980s, newly emerging off-farm opportunities in nearby towns and outside agriculture became the key drivers of growth and change, profoundly influencing poverty, income mobility, and inequality in Palanpur. Individual entrepreneurship and initiative is found to play a critical role in driving and responding to the forces of change; and yet, against a backdrop of real economic growth and structural transformation, this book shows that human development outcomes have shown only weak progress and remain stubbornly resistant to change.


In the last four decades, the world has been significantly impacted by globalization and rapid technological changes. This in turn had major effects on the global economy. Several developing and socialist economies that earlier followed closed door and import substitution policies started to open up their economies to world trade and investments. Some such countries, as India, managed to achieve a degree of economic prosperity over the last few years after opening up their economy.
