Malini Seshadri - She is a newspaper, magazine, radio and television journalist and interviewer. She also translates Tamil fiction and poetry.

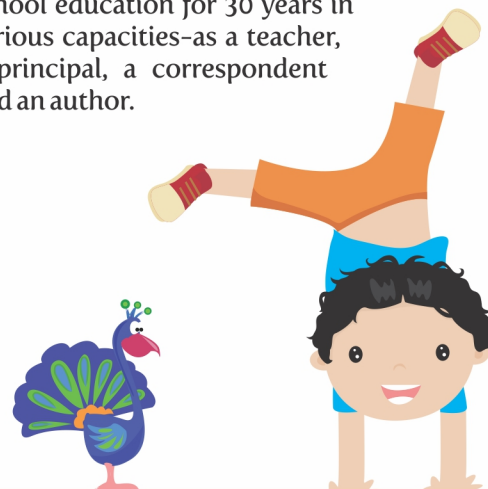
Sumathi Sudhakar - She is the writer of children's books (Rupa, Scholastic India) and formerly on the editorial panel of Chandamama magazine.
