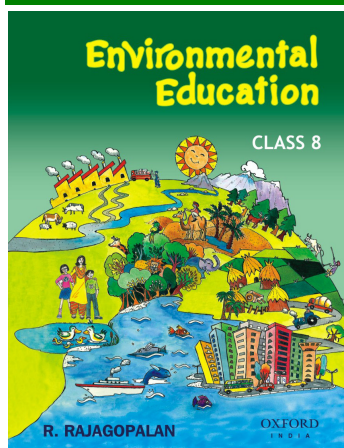


Environmental Education

This syllabus has been also adopted by the Council for the Indian School Certificate Examinations (CISCE) for the compulsory subject, Environmental Education, from the academic year 2005-2006.

- Reinforce concepts through challenging exercises and activities at the end of each chapter

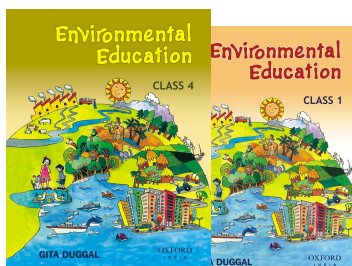
Book 6 to 8
